	Front cover has: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - title (e.g. Sea otter: threatened species) - picture (coloured) - Latin name in <i>italics</i> (e.g. <i>Enhydra lutris</i>) - ID Box (your name, class, date) 	15
	Description of animal: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - what it looks like - structural adaptations - behaviours - reproduction - what it eats - additional interesting information 	16
	Habitat: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - where the animal lives (e.g. rainforest, prairie) - why is the animal well suited for its habitat (e.g. its food is abundant, the temperature is correct etc.) 	14
	Population and Distribution: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - statistics/numbers of how many of the animal are left in the world - where they are located (specific geographic areas are mentioned.) 	14
	Threats: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - what is causing the animal to be endangered (e.g. hunting, loss of habitat, climate change etc.) 	14
	Protections and Recovery Efforts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - describe laws that protect the animal - organizations that protect the animal (e.g. world wildlife fund. - have these efforts helped increase or stabilize the population. 	15
	References: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - must list all resources used e.g. books, encyclopedias, magazines, internet sites etc. <p>Note: websites must be specific. A search engine (www.google.ca) is NOT acceptable www.nwf.org (national wildlife federation) is acceptable</p>	12
